

Born in Thessaloniki, Greece, where he completed his basic and university studies in the Department of Education and Psychology, Faculty of



Philosophy at Aristotle University of Thessaloniki (AUTH). He completed his postgraduate studies in the same faculty, with specialization in School Education. Afterwards, he continued his postgraduate studies in Pedagogics, Psychology and Classical Philology at the University of Freiburg, Germany, where in 1989 he received his Ph.D. in Philosophy. He worked as a research associate at the Institute of Pedagogy at the University of Freiburg and as a freelance for the teaching of Modern Greek Language at the People's University

of Freiburg.

Then he worked initially as a Lecturer and then as an Assistant Professor on the subject "School Education" in the Department of Education of AUTH in Florina and at the same period he was the supervisor of the experimental schools of this Department.

Subsequently he served as an Associate Professor in the Department of Early Childhood/ Education, AUTH on the subject "School Education" and became a member of the Scientific Committee of the Children's Centre of AUTH.

Since 2005, he teaches in AUTH in the field of "School Education and New Technologies" at the School of Philosophy and Pedagogy and is responsible for coordinating the training of the Department's students in Computer Science, initially as an Associate Professor and since 2012 as a Professor.

In teaching at undergraduate studies, one of his courses is about the teacher-pupil interaction; the interaction and social relations in the classroom in general. His other course is about the general debate on the introduction of new technology in education, focusing on the particular possibilities of planning courses with the support of New Technology, and the role of learning theories in developing educational software.

As an Associate Professor at the postgraduate studies of the Department of Education, School of Philosophy and Pedagogy his courses are : "Technologies of Information and Communication as a tool of the Intellect" and "Educational Software Applications and their Assessment" for the specialization "New Technologies in Education" . For three academic years he also taught the basic subject "Development and Evaluation of Curriculum" in collaboration with the Assistant Professor Mr. K. Bonidis.

He also participates in the Interdisciplinary Postgraduate Program entitled "Psychopedagogics of Integration: A school for all", offered by the School of Early Childhood Education, the School of Philosophy and Pedagogy, AUTH and the School of Preschool Education and Educational Planning, University of Aegean. He is designated by the General Assembly as a coordinator of the specialization "Psychopedagogical components of multiculturalism." He teaches the course "Interaction issues between children of linguistic-cultural minorities" and supervises the practical training of graduate students of the above specialization.

He has issued forty papers in scientific conferences, workshops and seminars in scientific areas such as "Issues of Curriculum," "Human relations and interaction in educational institutions", "Education and training of teachers", "Development of Pedagogical Science" and "New Technologies in Education". His scientific writings include five books; one is the edited version of his PhD published by an international publishing house, two are research monographs and two scientific treatises. He was a member of the writing team in seven collective volumes, he has published six articles in foreign journals. Also, eight of his articles are included in the records of foreign language international conferences, twelve in the records of Panhellenic Conferences and nine in Greek journals. Additionally he is the scientific researcher of three entries in the 'Dictionary of Pedagogy'.

He has participated in numerous training or research programs either as a trainer or as a member of the Panel, in one case as the scientific director and in another case as the associate scientific director. He is a member of the Pedagogical Society of Greece and served as the president of its Macedonia Branch (2007 - 2010). He is a member of the Greek Scientific Union of Information and Communication Technologies in Education, as well as a member of the European Association for Research on Learning and Instruction (EARLI) and the European Early Childhood Education Research Association (EECERA).

In September 2010 he was assigned responsible for the Research Action 'From distance / online further education of teachers "of the" Operational Program for Education and Lifelong Learning "and the Act" Education of foreigners and repatriated pupils ', with scientific coordinator the Professor of AUTH Mrs Anna Anastasiadis-Symeonidis.

Since September 2011 he is coordinating the research team within the NSRF 2011 Project "THALES – Strengthening of the research and innovation through basic and applied research and the attraction of high level researchers from abroad." For the implementation of the survey scientists

from five (5) Higher Education Institutes will cooperate with the support of four (4) invited researchers of international reputation from four different universities abroad.

Finally, as a representative of AUTH and in particular of the Department of Philosophy and Education, he will coordinate the second - by a total of three – research team assigned with the project "Coordination and Supervision of applied research", under the direction of Prof Mrs Eurydice Zachopoulou who is responsible for the entire project; the overall duration of the specific project will be 4 years from 2011 through 2015.

Since the academic year 2004/05 he is the Director in one of the two Teacher Training Centres of Central Macedonia.

He was a member of the committee of the European Educational Programmes of AUTH (2007 - 2010) and since September 2011 he is the Deputy Chairman of the School of Philosophy and Pedagogy. Since September 2013, he is the Director of the Department of Education of the School.

He has also participated in the scientific and organizing committee of numerous conferences, and was the president of the organizing committee once.
