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Christos Douskos has been educated in the University of Edinburgh and the University of Athens. His main areas of expertise include the philosophy of mind and language, metaphysics, as well as ethics and the philosophy of action.

Christos has been working extensively in the area of habits, skills and knowing-how, seeking to understand the kind of normativity that permeates the unreflective manifestation of agential powers. More recently, Christos has worked in the area of social and political philosophy of language. This work seeks to understand how certain habitual modes of thought affect the exercise of linguistic capacities, and the implications of this for the kind of normativity that underlies the use of language.

Christos has taught at the University of Patras, the University of Athens, the Hellenic Open University, and has been a visiting scholar at Birkbeck College, University of London. He has been the recipient of several grants and awards from the University of Edinburgh, the Greek State Scholarship Foundation (IKY) as well as the Greek Secretariat of Research and Technology (GSRT).
